Project: CPCRN Scholars Workgroup

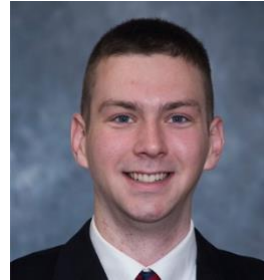
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About: The CPCRN Scholars Workgroup strives to educate students, postdoctoral fellows, junior faculty, practitioners, and other health professionals in dissemination and implementation (D&I) science focused on cancer prevention and control and health equity. Scholars will be provided with opportunities to engage in mentored projects with workgroups or CPCRN projects that most align with their interests. Scholars will have different tracks (i.e., researcher, practitioner, and student) with a competency-based curriculum and webinars for engagement. Through a formalized process, it is our hope that we can increase: the depth and breadth of the Scholars' connectedness within the CPCRN, a diverse cancer research pipeline, and applied D&I work in academic and clinical settings. Workgroup products are a D&I curriculum, evaluation of curricula, and Scholars' productivity after the training.

Planned Products and Deliverables:

- Update the CPCRN Scholars Program curriculum around the practitioner-focused track
- Analyze evaluation data from year 1 of the Program and summarize findings; avenues of interest through which members seek to disseminate these results include publications and conference presentations
- Consider longer-term evaluation of the Program via an alumni survey
- Continue efforts to recruit and prepare for Scholars cohort 3
